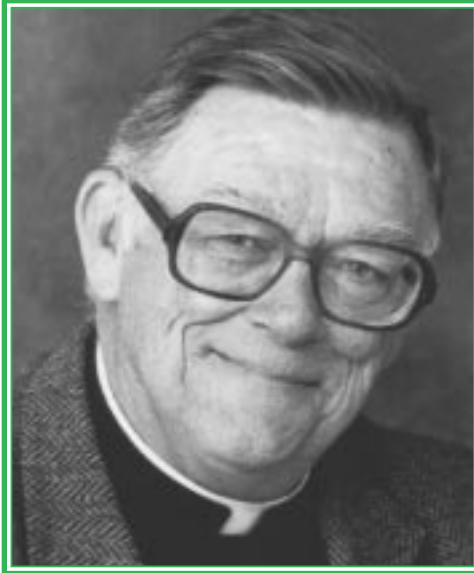

## PLANNED GIVING CENTER

### Becoming Tax Savvy

This month we're going to focus on a few of the specific tax advantages that you as a donor should be aware of when making a charitable gift. The following examples are just that—examples—and we offer them in the hopes that you might get a clearer picture of the potential tax savings available to you. As always, when planning a sizeable gift you should consult your financial adviser about how charitable donations affect your particular financial situation.

Did you know that Congress has created many tax incentives for donors making charitable gifts? These incentives are “subsidies” in effect, and require the government to share with you in the cost of making a charitable donation. Consider these examples:

**Example: You decide to donate \$1,000 to the Share Foundation capital campaign. The gift generates a \$1,000 income tax deduction. If your income is taxed at a 31% marginal rate, the deduction produces a tax savings of \$310 (the government “subsidy” of your gift). The net cost to you: \$690.**

**Example: After serious consideration, you decide to make a \$10,000 bequest in your will to the Share Foundation endowment fund. The bequest generates a \$10,000 estate tax deduction. If your estate is taxed at a 55% marginal rate, the deduction produces an estate tax savings of \$5,500. In this case, the government “subsidy” is more than one-half the value of the gift!**

Suppose you and your spouse have decided to make a lifetime gifts of appreciated property? Such gifts generate even greater tax savings because the donor avoids paying capital gains taxes.

**Example: Years ago you purchased stock for \$10,000. Today the stock's value has doubled and is worth \$20,000! If you decide to make a lifetime gift of the stock to Share Foundation, you will generate an income tax deduction of \$20,000. If your income is taxed at a 31% marginal rate, the deduction produces a \$6,100 income tax savings. Moreover, you will not have to pay any taxes on the capital gains. If your capital gains are taxed at a rate of 20%, the gift avoids capital gains taxation of \$2,000 (20% times \$10,000 gain). Total tax savings: \$8,100.**
