FROM THE DESK OF FATHER BLANEY...



Sharing Meadows is a peaceful spot. A visitor realizes that with their first steps on the land. The peacefulness comes from the people who live here. It is also from the land itself!

Besides the many acres of well-tended grass, there are several thousand trees! We plant 200 trees each year. About half are black walnut trees. When those trees reach maturity, they will be harvested for the wood. Black walnut tree wood is very expensive. When we plant 100 black walnut trees each year, at maturity, the wood would be worth \$3,000 each. If even

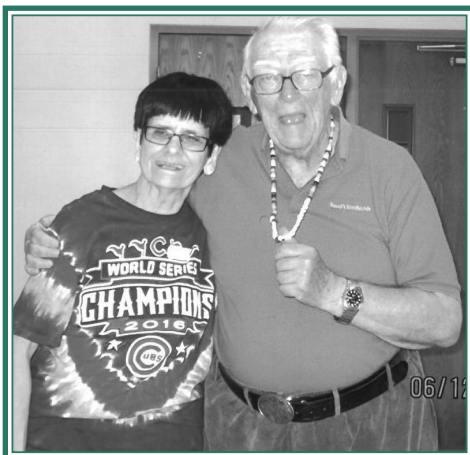
half reach maturity, they would give us $50 \times \$3,000 = \$150,000$, and that would certainly cover the cost of food for the 15 homes for about two years. Currently, we are harvesting lots of black walnuts. We sell them and we use them here in a variety of foods.

Besides these uses of our trees, the high number of trees also helps the environment. That is important! Our environment is very important! And our numbers of trees helps produce cleaner air. We can be proud of our efforts in this regard. We have approximately planted 200 years for 25 years and most have taken root! That amounts to approximately 5,000 trees.
